As part of our ongoing commitment to the IFA's **Football For All** campaign, to **Kick It Out** and to equality, anyone caught making racist or sectarian comments may be arrested, prosecuted and banned from the club.

A new Code of Conduct has been introduced by the IFA for senior clubs because of the implications under Article 55 of the FIFA Disciplinary Code. The potential measures available to the authorities for any instances of discrimination, racism or sectarianism in football range from match suspension and deduction of points (3 for a first offence, 6 for a second and relegation for persistent offenders) through to disqualification from a competition. Cliftonville FC is committed to complying in full with this Code of Conduct.

CLIFTONVILLE FC CODE OF CONDUCT

Supporters are asked to refrain from:

- using sectarian, racist or inappropriate language;
- using foul, abusive or insulting language, gestures or threatening behaviour;
- the display of any racist or sectarian emblems or banners; and
- missile throwing or entering the pitch area.

Supporters should also:

- respect all players, team attendants and match officials;
- follow directions and instructions given by stewards and club officials;
- respect other supporters;
- report breaches of the Code to a steward, club official or by using the telephone number above;
- remember to observe the Code both at Solitude and at any other venue; and
- support Cliftonville FC loudly and proudly

I agree to the above and understand that any inappropriate behaviour that breaches the club policy may result in the loss of my Member's Ticket and refusal of admittance to Cliftonville FC games.
